Work with a cluster of 6 UU churches to plan Escalating Inequality study and actions.

Will encourage a common read in my UU congregation.

Co-sponsor a classism workshop.

Organize an Interfaith Reproductive Justice Coalition. (Was going to do this before the conference.)

Study action x 1 yr.

Ted Talks in congregation.

Stay in contact and develop contacts at state level; UU Action networks

Classroom discussion.

National level: support UUJEC.

Get a letter signed by church: estate tax within a few months.

Health Care also.

Contact CA legislator to introduce a bill re-instating the estate tax – for educational earmarks

Continue working with justice committee to resolve these issues.

Become active in the 2016 election to promote the change we've been discussing.

Complete form for Statement of Conscience. Collaborate with another member on this.

Incorporate feedback received for the UUJEC curriculum (into that curriculum): Ted talks; personal stories.

Write article about fundamental fallacies of how insurance is set up to work in the US.

Incorporate ideas & information about inequality & how to begin addressing it into a study/action program for our congregation.

Get a local legislator for estate tax for education. (May)

Coordinate with Michael Greenman MTA GA.

Build stronger Assoc UU's Oregon on common issues.

Get my church to vote to join MTA faith Caucus. (before annual meeting)

Compile & verify 15 neighborhood account for 80% homicides 7 get poverty info for the same neighborhoods.
